A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

NOTES

- 1. The above financil results, reviewed by the Audit Committee, were approved at the meeting of the Board of Directors held on February 6, 2015. Limited Review of these results, as required under clause 41 of the Listing Agreement, has been completed by the Statutory Auditors.
- 2. Exceptional item for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2014 represents provision of Rs. 45.29 lakhs for diminution in value of investments.
- 3. During the quarter, disproportionate downward trend in the prices of cotton and yarn continued to affect heavily in the performance of the company.
- 4. Depreciation for the quarter ended December 31, 2014, September 31, 2014 and nine months ended December 31, 2014 has been computed based on the Company's technical evaluation of useful lives of its fixed assets, which in certain cases are different from those mentioned in Schedule II to the Companies Act, 2013. Based on transitional provision provided in Schedule II, WDV of Rs.27.78 Lakhs as on March 31, 2014 in respect of assets whose useful life is already exhausted have been charged to retained earnings. Had the company followed useful lives as per the previous policy, depreciation for the quarter ended December 31, 2014, September 30, 2014 and nine months ended December 31, 2014 would have been higher by Rs.14.14 lakhs, Rs.14.14 lakhs and Rs.42.42 Lakhs respectively.
- 5. The company's primary segment is identified as business segment based on nature of products, risks, return and the internal business reporting system (ie. cotton yarn) and operates in a single geographical segment as per Accounting Standard 17.

Figures for the previous periods have been regrouped/reclassified/amended, whereever necessary.
